

SOP – INTERNATIONAL STUDENT APPLICATION
(Only for Levels Sec 1-3 ONLY)

A) **International students (non-Singapore Citizens (SC) or non-Singapore Permanent Residents (SPR)) with at least one Singapore Citizen (SC) parent** who wish to seek admission to Secondary 1 to 3 can also write to contact@moe.gov.sg or approach MOE Customer Service Centre for assistance and advice, with the following information and supporting documents:

i) Information Required

- Academic year and Level you are seeking admission to for your child
- Singapore Residential Address
- Singapore Contact Number
- Email address

ii) Supporting Documents (Applicant)

- Birth Certificate
- Data Page of Passport

iii) Supporting Documents (Applicant's Parents)

- Singapore NRIC
- Data Page of Passport
- Marriage Certificate

The photocopies of the above supporting documents submitted should be legible. If the supporting documents are in other languages, an accurate English translation must accompany the photocopies. All supporting documents submitted for application purposes will not be returned to applicants.
