Dear Parents/Guardians of Sec 1/2 Students,

**Application for Special Access Arrangements (SAA)**  
**for Common Tests and Exams in 2018**

Specific access arrangements can be provided for your child based on his/her specific learning disability and medical condition. The arrangements can take the form of extra time, larger exam paper format and colored examination papers.

You should apply for SAA on behalf of your child only if you intend to do the same for his/her National Examination. Do bear in mind that annotations will be added to your child's certificate and transcript if he/she is provided with SAA during the National Examination. If your child is able to cope with the normal test/examination arrangements and you do not intend to apply for SAA during the National Examination, it is advisable that you do not apply for SAA for the school's tests and examinations to better prepare your child for the National Examination.

Should you decide to apply for Special Access Arrangements on behalf of your child, please submit the attached reply slip together with a copy of the relevant medical reports and documents to the school. Approval will only be granted for applications with valid medical reports.

For Secondary 2 students who had submitted a valid medical report to the school in 2017, only the reply slip will be required this year. However, if your child's medical report was issued more than 2 years ago, please renew the medical report prior to your SAA application for your child in Secondary 3.

Please submit your application by 29 January 2018 in order for your child to be given the appropriate Special Access Arrangements for Common Test 1.
