





- Being able to perform and attain a good aggregate of EMB3 to progress to next level of education and course of choice



Progression Pathways for Sec 4N(A)

1	Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)	ELMAB3≤ 12 (Excl CCA pts) + Course entry requirement
2	Direct-Entry-Scheme to Poly Program (DPP) – Higher NITEC	ELMAB3≤ 19 (Excl CCA pts) + Course entry requirement
3	Progression to ITE for NITEC course	Pre-requisites & bonus pts stated in booklet

- 50% Assessment Weighting for History Elective (HE) OR Geography Elective (GE)


HUMANITIES

- 3. History Explore critically the World Wars & Bi-polar World Order




Streaming Considerations



New Subjects

- Combined Humanities
- Depth in Understanding in all other subjects



Streaming Considerations

- All subjects allow students to gain entry into post secondary education [PFP / ITE DPP / Higher Nitec (3 years)/Nitec / Sec 5N(A)]
- It is not too early to start thinking about the post secondary education that you wish to study for. Understand their requirements and work towards it.
- Clarify post secondary requirements. If necessary, discuss with the teachers.
- The informed way to determine the right match of subject combination is by your results. You need to be realistic.

Streaming Results

- Streaming results will be emailed to students' ICON email account.
- It will indicate your assigned subject allocation.
- Each student is responsible to check their email and inform your parent/guardian of the result.

Appeal Process

- Does not guarantee you a place in your choice subject if you did not get it the first-time round
- Results still form the basis for subject allocation
- Reconsider based on certain circumstances
- Subject to vacancies in subjects, etc
- Appeal period is within 3 days once Streaming Results is emailed.
- Appeal results will be known 1 week after appeal period.

Streaming Timeline (Tentative)

- Term 4 Week 7 [25 October (1430) 28 October 2022 (2359)]
 - Submission of Streaming Option via FormSG
- Term 4 Week 9 (8 November 2022)
 - Streaming result will be emailed
- Appeal duration (8 November 10 November 2022)
- Appeal result by 17 November 2022

Out of Stream Subject (OoS)

- For current Subject Based Banding (SBB) students
 - Criteria: Pass Higher Stream Subject and pass all subjects
- For non-SBB students
 - Criteria: 75% for the subject (English / MT / Mathematics / Science) and pass all subjects with overall at least 60%. Feedback from subject teachers
 - To attend compulsory bridging lesson in November
