
Major Considerations

Progression Pathways for Sec 4 N(T)

No	Item	Eligibility Criteria
1	3-year Enhanced NITEC Foundation Programme	0 or 1 'N' Level pass
2	2-year NITEC courses	2 or more 'N' Level passes
3	3-year HIGHER NITEC (Offered from 2022 onwards)	3 'N' Level passes in EL/Maths/Science and two other subjects

Streaming Timeline (Tentative)


- Term 4 Week 7 (25 October (1430) 28 October 2022 (2359))

- Appeal result by 17 November 2022

Appeal Process

- Reconsider based on certain circumstances
- Subject to vacancies in subjects, etc
- Appeal period is within 3 days once Streaming Results is emailed.
- Appeal results will be known 1 week after appeal period.

Out of Stream Subject (OoS)

- For current Subject Based Banding (SBB) students
 - Criteria: Pass Higher Stream Subject and pass all subjects
