

ITE Early Admission Exercise (ITE EAE)

What is ITE EAE?

- An **aptitude-based** admissions exercise that allows students to apply for and receive conditional offers for admission to ITE prior to receiving their final grades.
- It allows ITE greater flexibility to select and admit students based on their aptitudes and interests, apart from academic grades, thus allowing a wider range of talents to be recognised.

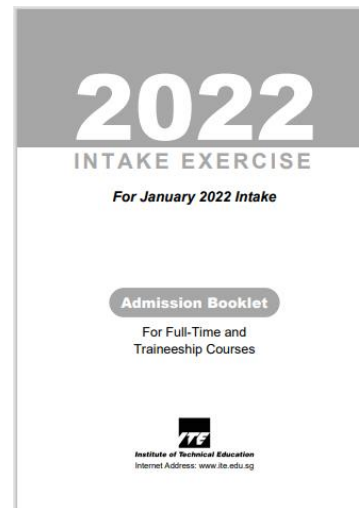
Confirmation of Conditional Offer

- Meet the **Minimum Entry Requirements (MERs)** for the course you have been offered under ITE EAE.

Note: Most Nitec or Higher Nitec courses have subject-specific MERS

You must meet these requirements or your offer will be revoked.

The MERs for each course can be found on the ITE website or the JIE Booklet (scan the QR code).

Minimum Entry Requirements for 3-year Higher Nitec courses

Since Academic Year 2022, ITE started offering a new curricular structure (for selected courses) that allows students to directly graduate with a Higher Nitec qualification after three years of training, instead of the four years.

Important dates for ITE EAE 2022

Application

Thu 26 May -
Wed 1 Jun 2022

- Apply up to 3 course choices
- Courses with the same title at different ITE Colleges are counted as separate choices.

Interview

Tue 21 Jun -
Thu 28 Jul 2022

- If you are shortlisted, the respective ITE College will notify you of the interview details via email, phone call or SMS.

Offer & Acceptance

Mon 22 Aug -
Fri 26 Aug 2022

- Log on to <https://istudent.ite.edu.sg> to check your application result.
- If your application is successful, you must accept the conditional offer online by Fri 26 Aug 2022. Otherwise your offer will be withdrawn.

Withdrawal

Mon 29 Aug -
Fri 2 Sep 2022

- If you decide to withdraw from the conditional offer after having accepted it earlier, you must submit your withdrawal request to training@ite.edu.sg by Fri 2 Sep 2022.

Preparing for your application

Write-up

- A write-up (of not more than 100 words) for each course choice.

Relevant documents

- Portfolio of related works/projects
- Participation in MOE Elective Modules and/or Applied Subjects or ITE Elective Modules
- Participation in work attachments, community/volunteer work, school/personal activities/projects, CCAs and competitions
- Relevant work experience
- Upload the supporting documents onto the online portal

Interview

- If you are shortlisted, the respective ITE College will notify you of the interview details via email, phone call or SMS.
- Bring along to the interview your portfolio of relevant works/projects and supporting documents, such as certificates, awards and testimonials.
- You may have to take an aptitude test when attending the interview, depending on the course.
- You will be notified to attend up to one interview for your choices with the same course title at two or more ITE Colleges.
- Be prepared for the interview by doing research and having answers to commonly asked interview questions.

FAQs on ITE EAE

What happens if the student qualifies for DPP/PFP after accepting the ITE EAE offer?

- ▶ Students who have accepted an ITE EAE offer and meet the MER are deemed to be admitted into the school and **not allowed** to participate in JIE after GCE 'N' Results.
- ▶ However, should the Sec 4N(A) student be eligible for DPP/PFP, they will be allowed to apply for DPP/PFP.
- ▶ Should the student accept a place via DPP or PFP, the student can apply to withdraw from the ITE EAE offer.

How many choices can I apply?

- ▶ You can apply for a maximum of 3 course choices.
- ▶ Please note that the same course offered at different ITE Colleges are considered separate choices e.g. the following is considered as 3 choices:
 - ▶ Business Services at ITE CC
 - ▶ Business Services at ITE CW
 - ▶ Business Services at ITE CE

Will I lose out if I don't apply for a an ITE course via ITE EAE?

- ▶ If you are not certain about your interests and aptitudes at this point in time, there are still other avenues to enter ITE, e.g. using your results to apply during JIE 'O'.
- ▶ However, if you have interests and/or aptitudes in certain ITE courses, you are encouraged to consider applying via ITE EAE.

I don't have to study once I receive an ITE EAE offer.

- ▶ Students with conditional ITE EAE offers need to meet the subject specific MERs for ITE courses in order for their offers to be confirmed.
- ▶ Students who do not meet the MERs will have their conditional offers revoked.
- ▶ The MERs ensure that students have the requisite academic foundation in order to cope with the rigour of the ITE course.
